

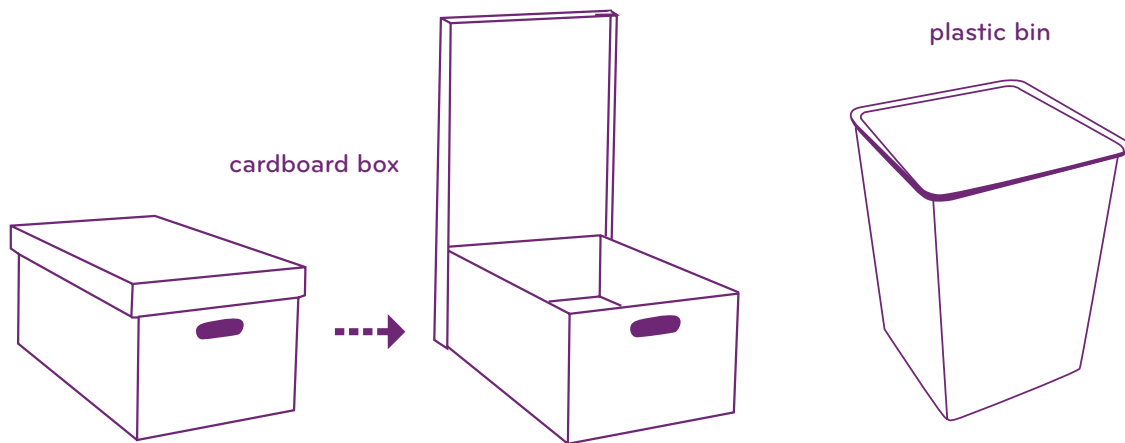
Donation Box Instructions

Materials

- a box or bin of your choosing
- construction paper, index cards or other sturdy paper
- markers
- tape or glue
- glitter, ribbons, stickers or other decorations (optional)

1. Decide what kind of box you want to use.

Consider how you will be using your donation box. Are you traveling to pick up your donations? Then you'll want to use a cardboard box with handles. Need a durable container that can withstand more wear and tear? Then use a plastic bin. Both options are easy to decorate for your event.



2. Affix the Great Sprout Tuck-In logo to your box.

Cut out the logo from page 3 of this document and tape or glue it onto your box.

3. Add a personalized message to your box.

Personalize your box with a “thank you” and a reminder that this box is for new books and new pajamas. If you’ve chosen a plastic bin, write your message on paper or index cards and affix them to the bin using tape. If you’ve chosen a cardboard box, you can either write your message directly on the box or use paper or index cards and affix them to the bin using tape or glue.

4. Apply the final touches in decorating your box.

Use markers along with glitter, ribbons, stickers or other decorations to tie your box design together. If you’ve chosen a plastic bin, make your creations on paper and index cards and affix them to the bin using tape. If you’ve chosen a cardboard box, you can apply your decorations directly to the box.
